Senior Center Membership required for 2023:

You must be a member of the Castle Rock Senior Center to be eligible to play in the Senior Center Bocce Ball League. If you have not joined and paid your dues for 2022-2023, please complete the Senior Center application and pay your annual membership fee. Be aware that the membership is on a rolling calendar year. Example: If you joined in March 2021, your membership will expire in March 2022.

The official sign-up deadline will be the Friday, February 17, 2023, for registration forms to be submitted to the Castle Rock Senior Center. The league fee/person will be collected at that time. Leagues will play indoor at the MAC in Castle Rock. The league fee includes court rental, balls, and administration. You do not pay anything in addition to the MAC as part of the league. Transportation will not be provided to the MAC from the Senior Center.

Note: The \$30 or \$55 league fee/person **MUST** accompany this Registration Form if you wish to play in this league. No early registrations will be accepted without the fee. Leagues are ‘open play’ with players moving from court to court as they win or lose to enable players to meet and play with more participants. The final week of the league is a tournament with prizes.

1) Player Eligibility

- a) **League** – Castle Rock Senior Activity Center members are eligible to participate in a Bocce Ball league through the MAC in Castle Rock. Play is held indoors at the MAC every Tuesday and Friday from 1:00 – 3:00 pm. The league consists of three sessions. Players must sign up separately for each session.

- Winter Session 3 – March-May. **Registration due by Feb 17th.**

- b) **Regular Team Players** –The Bocce Ball league will have up to 8 teams of 2 or 4 players depending on participation numbers. Teams will be ‘open play’ and will be randomly assigned each day of play. As teams win or lose they’ll move from court to court so everyone has a chance to meet and play with other participants. Bocce Ball is a social league and scores will not be tracked or monitored except for the final tournament. You must be a member of the Castle Rock Senior Center to be eligible to play in the league. The \$30 single session or \$55 both sessions league fee **MUST** accompany the registration form on the sign-up date or you will not be able to play. No early registration forms will be accepted without the league fee. Registration forms received after the official sign-up fee will not prorate the league fee. The late registrant will simply play out the remaining days in the session.

- Senior Center Membership required (50 years or older \$40/year dues)
- Senior Center Bocce Ball League Fee (\$30 per single or \$55 per both days due at sign-up)
