Senior Center Membership required for 2023:

You must be a member of the Castle Rock Senior Center to be eligible to play in the Senior Center Corn Hole League. If you have not joined and paid your dues for 2024, please complete the Senior Center application and pay your annual membership fee. Be aware that the membership is on a rolling calendar year. Example: If you joined in March 2023, your membership will expire in March 2024.

The official sign-up deadline will be the Thursday, January 4, 2024 for Session 2. All registration forms to be submitted to the Castle Rock Senior Center. The session fee will be collected at that time. Leagues will play indoor at the MAC in Castle Rock. The session fee includes court rental, equipment and administration. You do not pay anything in addition to the MAC as part of the league. Transportation will NOT be provided to the MAC from the Senior Center.

Note: The \$65 a session fee MUST accompany this Registration Form, if you wish to play in this league. No early registrations will be accepted without the fee. Leagues are 'open play' with players moving from court to court as they win or lose to enable players to meet and play with more participants.

2023/24 Castle Rock Senior Corn Hole League

1) Player Eligibility

- a) **League** – Castle Rock Senior Activity Center members are eligible to participate in the CRSAC corn hole league at the MAC in Castle Rock. Play is held indoors at the MAC every Wednesday from 1:00 – 3:00 pm. The league consists of two sessions. Players must sign up separately for each session.

Session 2 – Jan 10 – March 27, 2024 – Registration due Jan 4, 2024

- b) **Regular Team Players** –The Corn Hole league will have up to teams of 2 or 4 players depending on participation numbers. Teams will be ‘open play’ and will be randomly assigned each day of play. As teams win or lose they’ll move from court to court so everyone has a chance to meet and play with other participants. Corn Hole is a social league and scores will not be tracked or monitored. You must be a member of the Castle Rock Senior Center to be eligible to play in the league. The \$65 per session fee MUST accompany the registration form on the sign-up date or you will not be able to play. No early registration forms will be accepted without the session fee. Registration forms received after the official sign-up fee will not prorate the session fee. The late registrant will simply play out the remaining days in the session.

3) Corn Hole League Location:

- Play is on the indoor at the MAC in Castle Rock
- All players should arrive at the court at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start of play.

4) League Rules and Scoring

Rules - Each player has 20 seconds to throw their bean bag onto the other board during what is called “innings of play.” There isn't a set distance for how far each board should be away from each other. Any throw able distance is fine, but official rules created by the American Corn Hole Association state 27 feet as the proper distance for professional games. Each team will alternate tossing the bean bag underhand onto the board until all four bean bags are thrown. The player's feet must stay behind the leading edge of the board during each throw. Once all bean bags are thrown, each team will collect and re-throw.

Scoring - The main objective of the game is to get the bean bag into the hole, but it’s not the only way to earn points. Throwing a bean bag onto the board gets you one point, while throwing it into the hole gets you three points. Missing the board completely results in no points. Cancellation scoring is used in corn hole, meaning one player/team earns points each inning because points are subtracted from the opponent's score. For example, if Team A scores four points and Team B earns three, then the score for Team A is one point. Whichever team reaches exactly 21 points first wins.
